

## LIBRARIAN'S REPORT

A significant addition in 2013 has been a DVD of *The Ringing World* for the years 1941-1970. We already have *Bell News* (1881-1915) and *The Ringing World* (1911-1940) in this format, and bound volumes of *the Ringing World* from 1947 to date, so the coverage is now complete.

We have for many years had half a dozen books on indefinite loan from The Central Council. They have now been recalled, but copies of the two most valuable ones, *An account of church bells, with some notices of Wiltshire bells*, by W C Lukis (1857), and *The church bells of Cornwall*, by E H W Dunkin(1878), are still available locally in the Somerset Archaeological and Natural History Society's library.

Our Association library remains at St Mary's Church, Bridgwater, where it is open to personal callers by appointment with me, most conveniently on Monday practice, and to postal, telephone and e-mail enquiries at any time. The catalogue, updated annually, is on the Association website, and I can supply a paper copy on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope,
