

Young Ringer Award

Notes to Tower Captains, Tutors and Students

- a. Any member of the Association who is under 19 can enter.
- b. Each person can only enter either the 'Young Ringer Award' or the 'Young Ringer of the Year Competition' each year.
- c. The 'Young Ringer Award' modules are intended for younger ringers at the start of their ringing lives to encourage them to build the skills necessary to enter the 'Young Ringer of the Year Competition'.
- d. The modules can be downloaded from the Association website or obtained from the Association Education Officer.
- e. The modules can be started at any time. If the ringer is not a total beginner when starting the modules the tasks should be discussed with the Tutor or Tower Captain and the tasks already completed crossed before starting the award.
- f. The tasks can be completed in any order.
- g. There is no time limit for the 'Young Ringer Award' modules. Each person may take as long as they wish to complete the three modules.
- h. It is expected that the Tower Captain or Tutor will guide the student's choice of entry (to either the 'Young Ringer Award' or the 'Young Ringer of the Year Competition').
- i. £5 is awarded for the completion of every task.
- j. In order to receive your money the sheets with tasks completed on them should be sent to the Branch Education Officer at the end of February each year. The money will be paid annually at the Association AGM.
- k. It is in the interest of the development of student's ringing skills that they are able to perform a task to a high standard regularly before it is signed off.
- l. Please keep a register of attendance at practice nights and service ringing.
