

THE BATH AND WELLS DIOCESAN ASSOCIATION OF CHANGE RINGERS YOUTH STRIKING COMPETITION Rules

ELIGIBILITY

All team members must be under 19 on the day of the Competition.

A Branch unable to field a complete team may borrow ringers from other branches to complete the team.

A Branch may enter more than one team.

FORMAT

Teams may choose to ring either Call Changes or a touch of Doubles or Minor.

A Trophy will be awarded to the winning team.

CALL CHANGES

Call Changes must be rung for four minutes (this will be timed for the band by the organiser in the tower, or a person attending with the team may do this).

METHOD

The touch shall be 120 changes of Doubles or Minor

FOR BOTH CALL CHANGES AND METHOD

The test piece will begin and end in rounds.

The rounds before and after the test piece will not be marked.

Rows will be marked from the first change, to the first row of rounds at the end (inclusive).

Bells failing to set will not be marked.

STARTING SIGNAL

The signal for the start of the test piece shall be two whole pulls on the treble.

GENERAL

Each team will be allowed 2 minutes practice, and extra time to adjust ropes if necessary.

Teams may choose to have a non-ringing conductor (of any age) to call their test piece if they wish.

Teams should not be coached during the test piece.

The Judges' decision is final.
