What will we ring?

Whatever you want to have a go at! We will certainly be ringling rounds, call changes and plain hunt. And we can ring Plain Bob, Grandsire or other methods if you'd like to. There will be adult ringling there to help you and perhaps give you the chance to try something new.



What should we bring?

Each young ringling should bring £2 as their contribution to the tower fees for the day. You'll also need money for your pub lunch and drinks.
