10.30 - 11.15 **St Mary's Walton, Clevedon.** BS21 7BY, 6 bells, 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ cwt. Toilet in the church

11.30 - 12.15 **All Saints, Clevedon.** BS21 6AU 5 bells, 12 cwt.

3.15 - 4.00 **Wraxall, All Saints, BS48 1NA,** 8 bells, 23 cwt. Toilet in the church.

Tea at Tyntesfield House. BS48 1NT. There is a restaurant in the Home Farm Visitor Centre, right next to the car park, which serves everything from hot meals to your typical National Trust tea. They are expecting us, and sound very welcoming. There will be no need to pay to go in, as we won't get as far as the entrance to the house. Non-ringers might like to be dropped here during the lunch break and left to go around the house and estate until we get back.

5.30 - 6.15 **Abbots Leigh, Holy Trinity, BS8 3QT,** 6 bells, 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ cwt. Toilet in the church.
