Errata - 2009-2010 report

Unfortunately there were errors in the last 14 rows of Peals Summary spread sheet (p73). The 6 rows from 3 Plain Minor to 14 Surprise Minor should be in the Minor column. The last 8 rows should be in the Major column, and the totals changed appropriately.

General

184 ringers took part in 269 peals; an increase of 84 peals over last year, bringing the total number of peals for the Association to over 10,000. There were 37 conductors. 51 peals were rung outside of the Association territory, including one in Dordrecht, and one in Adelaide, South Australia. 61 peals were rung on secular bells. There were 10 handbell peals. First peals were recorded for augmented 6 at Priddy, the Bakery Wedmore, Brompton Regis and Taunton St Andrew. A clever composition of 60 spliced maximus was rung at Shepton Beauchamp. 8 peals were rung to celebrate the Royal Wedding.
